### Writing the date

When you write the date you must put the day first, month second and last the year.

Day	Month	Year
13th	April	2016

### Shortened Form

25th December 2015 = **25 / 12 / 2015**

19th March 2013 = **19 / 03 / 2013**

## *Saying the date*

When you say the date you must use 'the' before the day and 'of' before the month.

25th December 2015 = **The** twenty-fifth **of** December Two thousand and fifteen

19th March 2013 = **The** 19th **of** March Two thousand and thirteen
